



PROCESS FOR INSTRUCTIONALLY EMBEDDED ASSESSMENTS

1 CHOOSE

Choose an Essential Element and linkage level for a student using the Instruction and Assessment Planner in Kite® Educator Portal.

More than one Essential Element can be chosen at a time.



These assessments are optional for Year-End model states but required for Instructionally Embedded model states.


Check your state's page of the DLM® website for assessment window dates.

2 TEACH

Provide instruction on the chosen Essential Element.

The linkage level can be changed in the Instruction and Assessment Planner if the student demonstrates different skills during instruction.



3 ASSESS

Return to the Instruction and Assessment Planner to assign a testlet for the chosen Essential Element and linkage level, which will be delivered in Kite Student Portal.

The testlet's Testlet Information Page (TIP) is accessed directly in the Instruction and Assessment Planner.

5 REPEAT

Repeat the process throughout the assessment window.

4 EVALUATE

Consider the assessment results provided in the Instruction and Assessment Planner to plan continued instruction on the Essential Element assessed or move on to a different Essential Element.
